Palmer is the director of advocacy and chapter support for the Autism Society of North Carolina and was also awarded their Literary Work of the Year in 2007. She is the author of two books, "Realizing the College Dream with Autism or Asperger's Syndrome: A Parent's Guide to Student Success" and "Parenting Across the Autism Spectrum: Unexpected Lessons We've Learned."

Speaking from both personal and professional experience, Palmer will discuss challenges that students on the autism spectrum frequently face in college, and offer tips to help students and families prepare for this important transition. She will also discuss the importance of self-advocacy, and the parent's role in supporting students.
